Subject: Recreation Event

A request for a Recreation Event Special Use Permit (SUP) on the Hume Lake Ranger District was received from Kingsburg 4WD Club. After having reviewed Kingsburg's request, I am granting a SUP for the purpose of holding an Over-Snow 4WD Event on the Hume Lake Ranger District. In our review, no extraordinary circumstances were found to exist.

This permit falls under the Categories Established by the Chief of actions for which a Case File and Decision memo are not required. Categorically excluding this action from further documentation under FSH 1909.15 category 32.12.8, Orders issued pursuant to 36 CFR 261 – "Approval, modification, or continuation of minor, short-term (1 year or less) special uses of National Forest System lands" is appropriate because it is for a short duration, and it is necessary to lessen the potential for further resource damage caused by the public using motor vehicles while recreating in the area. No extraordinary circumstances exist.
