Springville Workcenter Access Road (Forest Road 21S15B) Repair/Maintenance

Purpose and Need:

Forest Road 21S15B accesses the the southern portion of the Springville Workcenter. The road is unpaved. Much of the original road surface (decomposed granite) has eroded off from past weather events, resulting in rills and rutting. There is a need to restore the road's original contour and grade and resurface the top of the road with decomposed granite.

Decision

I have decided to authorize the use of a small excavator to grade and restore the road to its original contour and grade. Then decomposed granite will be applied and leveled with the small excavator and handtools. The project is expected to occur late winter or early spring of 2018 and work will be conducted by Forest Service personnel or a contractor.


