These rare plants also occur in one or all three allotments.


Hot springs fimbristylis	<i>Fimbristylis thermalis</i>	CRPR 2B.2

Small leaved monkeyflower	<i>Mimulus microphyllus</i>	CRPR 4.3

Additionally these animals occur on one or all three allotments

tricolored blackbird	<i>Agelaius tricolor</i>	CE Federal candidate
burrowing owl	<i>Athene cunicularia hypugaea</i>	CSC
